# ÖZYEĞİN UNIVERSITY DIRECTIVES ON INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ADMISSIONS TO UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS

(Senate Date: 09.06:2023; Senate No: 2023/11)

## Purpose

**ARTICLE 1** - (1) The purpose of these directives is to govern the principles for international student admissions to undergraduate programs offered by the Özyeğin University faculties and schools.

## Scope

**ARTICLE 2-**(1) These directives cover the terms and conditions pertaining to the quotas as well as the application, evaluation, admission, and enrollment processes applicable for international student admissions to Özyeğin University's undergraduate programs.

## Legal Ground

**ARTICLE 3** -(1) These directives are prepared pursuant to the Article 14 of the Higher Education Law No:2547.

## Definitions

**ARTICLE 4** – (1) For the purpose of these Directives, the following terms shall have the following meanings hereinafter:

- a) Dean: Deans of the Özyeğin University Faculties,
- b) Faculty: Faculties of Özyeğin University
- c) Faculty/School Executive Board: Executive Boards of the Özyeğin University Faculties and Schools,
- d) English Preparatory Program: Özyeğin University English Preparatory Program,
- e) English Proficiency Examination: Özyeğin University English Proficiency Examination,
- f) Director: Directors of the Özyeğin University Schools,
- g) Board of Trustees: Board of Trustees of Özyeğin University,
- h) Student Services: Özyeğin University Student Services Directorate,
- i) OSYS: Student Selection and Placement System,
- j) Rector: Özyeğin University Rector,
- k) Senate: Özyeğin University Senate,
- I) TÖMER: Turkish and Foreign Languages Research and Application Center,
- m) International Office: International Office Unit of Özyeğin University,
- n) University (OzU): Özyeğin University,
- o) University Executive Board: University Executive Board of Özyeğin University,
- p) International Admissions Committee: Application, evaluation, and admission committee for international students
- q) School: Özyeğin University Schools.

## Quota:

**ARTICLE 5** – (1) The international student quota of each undergraduate program is determined with the resolution of the Board of Trustees upon the recommendation of the Senate. The quota takes effect pursuant to the approval of the Higher Education Council (YÖK).

(2) In the absence of any application to the respective program or in the event the quota is not filled, the available or remaining quota can be transferred to the quotas of other programs by the Senate, excluding that of the Faculty of Law. The transfer of the available or remaining quotas to the quota of the Faculty of Law can only be performed upon the resolution of the Higher Education Executive Board.

## **Primary Application Requirements**

**ARTICLE 6** – (1) Students must be either in the senior year of high school or must have graduated from the high school at the time of application. Only the students who satisfy the nationality and educational background requirements specified in the Higher Education Council's Principles of International Student Admissions are eligible to apply.

(2) The nationality and educational background requirements are announced on the University website.

### Examinations, Base Scores, and Diplomas Required for Applications

**ARTICLE 7-** Eligible applicants must meet the requirements for national or international examinations or diplomas and base scores listed in Attachment 1. New examinations or application requirements can be included upon the resolution of the Senate.

(2) High school exit examinations (such as Abitur, International Baccalaureate, GCE, Tawjihi) do not have any limitation on the period of validity. However, the validity period of university entrance examinations (such as SAT) is two years.

(3) Prospective students from countries not listed among the application requirements are also eligible to apply so long as they can submit their General High School Diploma.

### Application Process and Documents

**ARTICLE 8-** (1) Applications are submitted online via the application page within the announced application period with the application documents listed below.

(2) If application documents are prepared in a language other than Turkish or English, their notarized translation into Turkish or English must also be attached to the original document.

- a. If graduated, the high school diploma;
- b. Transcript showing all courses taken and grades achieved during high school education;
- c. If available, proof of Turkish and/or English proficiency listed in Article 14 and 15;
- d. Copy of the pages from the passport that have a photo and identity information;
- e. Letter of intent,
- f. For Turkish nationals who completed their high school education abroad: Arrival and departure record (entry and exit record) downloaded with a barcode from the e-government site, covering the period of study in the respective high school.

(3) Depending on the applied academic program, any additional document that might be required by the University are announced on the university website. The additional documents, if any, must be submitted at the time of enrollment.

(4) Applications of prospective students who do not satisfy the application requirements and who fail to complete necessary application information and documents within the announced dates are not processed. Amendments and attachments to application information and documents are not allowed after the end of the application period.

(5) Prospective students may be requested to prove the accuracy of information and documents submitted at the time of application or the University may directly investigate the accuracy of such information and documents. Should it be determined that there are inconsistencies in information and documents provided by prospective students, such students are denied admission even if they are previously admitted, and their enrollments are revoked, even if previously completed.

(6) As a result of preliminary evaluations to be conducted based on the application information and documents submitted, prospective students may be invited for an interview by the respective department, if deemed necessary. Interviews can be conducted on the University's campus as well any other location or via any method the University may deem appropriate.

#### **International Admissions Committee**

**ARTICLE 9** - (1) The International Admissions Committee is established by the Rector. The Commission Chair is appointed by the Rector.

(2) The International Admissions Committee is responsible for reviewing the applications of students who apply to the University through the international student quota, and fulfilling any other duties assigned to them within the scope of the legislation.

#### **Evaluation and Admission**

**ARTICLE 10** - (1) Applications are submitted to the International Office with the required documents within the announced application period. The International Admissions Committee evaluates applications based on the application requirements and documents specified in Article 7 and 8 of these directives, and accordingly either accepts or rejects applications in line with the available quota.

#### Notification of Results and Intention for Enrollment

**ARTICLE 11-** (1) Results are notified to prospective students by the International Office via email. The notification is sent to the email address provided by the student at the time of application.

(2) The International Office sends a letter to all admitted students via email. The letter includes information about the required advance payment procedures and enrollments. In lieu of students who fail to

initiate the necessary proceedings or make their advance payment within the announced period, waitlisted candidates, if any, are notified. Advance payments made by students are offset with the tuition of the first semester. Students who make the advance payment but fail to complete their enrollments are not refunded. However, students who are not granted with student visas can be refunded provided that they submit an application to the University with the necessary documentation.

(3) Once the admitted students start their enrollment procedures and make their advance payments, the International Office sends a "letter of acceptance" or an equivalent document which is required for student visa applications.

## Visa and Residence Permit Procedures

**ARTICLE 12** - (1) Admitted international students must enter Turkey with their student visas. Students must apply to the Turkish Consulate located either in their country of residence (or in the nearest country) for their student visa by submitting their letter of acceptance. It is the responsibility of prospective students to complete the student visa procedures and cover any and all relevant costs. Special cases where the student visa requirement is not applicable are posted on the University website.

(2) Students must obtain their residence permits for educational purposes within at the latest one month as of their date of entrance to Türkiye. Students holding a residence permit issued outside of Istanbul must transfer their residence files to Istanbul from the respective city as soon as they complete their enrollment. It is the responsibility of students to complete the necessary procedures for their residence permit and cover any and all relevant costs.

(3) The list of visa and residence permit documents required by the University is determined as per the effective rules and regulations and general instructions of authorized public institutions on international students.

## **Enrollments and Enrollment Documents**

**ARTICLE 13** -(1) Admitted students must apply to Student Services to complete their enrollments. Students are required to complete their enrollments in person within the announced dates by submitting the documents required by the University.

(2) During enrollment, in addition to the original copies of the application documents that were previously submitted and the original copies of the documents that are translated, admitted students are also expected to provide the following documents:

a) The original copy of the high school diploma or, if not available yet, the original copy of the temporary certificate of graduation,

b) An "Equivalence Letter" obtainable from the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Türkiye, certifying the equivalency of the diploma to that of a Turkish high school,

c) An annotated student visa obtained from the Turkish Consulate located in the country of residence (or, if not available, in the nearest country),

d) 2 passport-size photographs,

e) For Turkish nationals who completed their high school education abroad: Arrival and departure record (entry and exit record) downloaded with a barcode from the e-government site, covering the period of study in the respective high school.

f) For Turkish nationals who have renounced Turkish citizenship: Blue card and foreign passport,

g) For Turkish citizens: TR Identity Card and Turkish passport,

h) For dual nationals: Both the TR and foreign passports, TR Identity Card, and the extract of civil registry record,

i) For international students: Passport and, if any, residence permit.

j) Depending on the applied academic program, any additional documents that might be required by the University.

3) Students cannot enroll via mail or with incomplete documents. Students who fail to complete their enrollments within the announced dates forfeit all their rights.

4) Students who fail to pay their tuition within the announced period are not enrolled.

5) Should it be determined that the student has submitted forged or altered enrollment documents or the student has committed a fraud in the university entrance examination, the enrollment of the student is revoked, and legal action is taken against the student. In the event the fraudulent student is already graduated, all documents including the diploma awarded to the student are revoked. Such students are not refunded for the tuition that they paid.

## **English Proficiency**

**ARTICLE 13** - (1) Students are required to prove their English proficiency in order to be eligible to start their undergraduate programs.

(2) Students must prove their English proficiency with the exam score reports of internationally recognized examinations. Such examinations, their validity periods and the minimum passing scores are determined by the Senate. Prospective students must submit their English Proficiency documents at the time of their application to the University. Students who prove their English Proficiency may directly matriculate in their undergraduate programs. Such students are not required to take the English Proficiency Examination administered by the University.

(3) Students who fail to submit any proof of their English Proficiency are required to take the English Proficiency Examination administered by the University. Such students must obtain at least the minimum passing score determined by the Senate.

(4) Students who fail to submit the score reports of the aforementioned examinations or who fail such examinations are required to attend the English Preparatory Program of the University.

(5) English Preparatory Program students are subject to the Rules and Regulations for the English Preparatory Program of the Özyeğin University School of Languages.

#### **Turkish Proficiency**

**ARTICLE 14** (1) Students who are enrolled in partially or entirely Turkish-medium programs must prove their Turkish proficiency.

(2) Students who obtained at least B1 (Intermediate) level score in the Turkish Proficiency Examinations administered by TÖMER or any other examination centers accredited by the Higher Education Council may start their undergraduate programs.

(3) The Turkish proficiency requirement is not applicable to students who completed their secondary education in Turkish-medium institutions in Türkiye over the past three years.

#### **Absence of Provisions**

**ARTICLE 15** – (1) In the absence of any relevant provision in these Directives, the provisions of other relevant legislations and resolutions rendered by the Higher Education Council, Senate, University Executive Board as well as the respective faculty/school executive boards will prevail.

#### Abolishment

**ARTICLE 16-** (1) "The Directives on International Student Admissions to Özyeğin University Undergraduate Programs", which was approved by the University Senate on May 30, 2014 during its meeting numbered 2014/06, has been abolished.

#### Effectiveness

**ARTICLE 17** -(1) These directives take effect upon the approval of the University Senate.

Execution

**ARTICLE 18** – (1) These directives are executed by the Özyeğin University Rector.
